




Creating an Autodesk Account

Creating an **Autodesk Account** is your key to accessing several Autodesk websites with a single sign-in. Your Autodesk ID is typically your email address, but can also be an alpha-numerical id you create. This gives you access to download software and manage your products and services.

To create an Autodesk Account:

1. Visit the Autodesk Account sign-in screen at accounts.autodesk.com.
2. Click the **Create an Account** link and follow the on-screen instructions.

What are the character requirements for my Autodesk ID?

We recommend you use your email address as your Autodesk ID. Your Autodesk ID does not have any character requirements. Your Password must be 8-12 characters and must contain at least 1 letter and 1 number. It cannot contain leading or trailing white space or "{" and "}" characters.

After I register and create an account, do I need to re-register for each website?

No. Your single sign-in account gives you access to the applicable websites using the same Autodesk ID and password. Your signed-in state is maintained as you navigate among these websites, although the session might time out after periods of inactivity.

Note: Some websites include separate site settings to configure preferences for features and functionality.
